Sacramental information:

Baptism: Registered faithful only. Please contact the office to arrange the date. Normally no baptisms on Sundays. Godparents must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old.

Confirmation: We will let you know when the Bishop will be coming. Be prepared by studying the catechism. Sponsors must be traditional practicing Catholics at least 16 years old. To enroll in Sunday program; see Mr. Michael Rayes via office. Email: catechism@ourladyofsorrows.org

Confessions: Times as listed, plus by consultation with one of the priests. Please try to come during the week if you live nearby. Be clear, complete, concise and contrite.

Marriages: Priest needs at least six months notice. This sacrament is only for those who registered faithful. Normally no weddings on Sundays.
